### **Group Lesson Session Dates**

**COST: \$605.00 for 11 weeks (ONE makeup)**

**Payment for current students due by Summer Week 9**

Up to 5 riders per group. Organized with riders of similar ability. Available for children 8 and up and adults. Lessons are 45 minutes long, same day and time each week, taught primarily in our indoor arena. Riders with some experience may require an evaluation lesson for class placement. Riders must provide their own helmet. Long pants and hard soled shoes with a small heel required. **Weight limit 160 lbs.**

**\*Only one makeup lesson is offered per session if students have given 24hr notice of absence. Makeup will take place on the 12<sup>th</sup> week of the current session and is same day/time as their regularly scheduled lesson. Makeup dates are listed below.\***

**Our Therapeutic Riding Program** (fully accredited through PATH Int.) on Tuesday is designed for those with physical, and/or mental challenges. We operate throughout the year, providing weekly therapeutic activities to children and adults with a variety of challenges, including but not limited to: amputations, autism, multiple sclerosis, traumatic brain injury, hearing and visual impairments. Benefits of therapeutic riding include enhancement of: balance, coordination, flexibility, muscle tone, verbal skills, posture, self-confidence, self-esteem, social skills, and learning skills. Physician's statement and evaluation ride are required before enrollment is approved. **Evaluation Fee - \$30.00, 11 Week Session Fee - \$605.00.**

**Beginner English Horsemanship**

**Cost: \$350 for 5 weeks**

**Girl Scout/Boy Scout Riding Program - \$60.00 per rider**

This program is two hours long. The first hour consists of a beginning riding lesson. The second hour is spent touring the barn and learning basic care. Children must be at least 8 years old and under 160 lbs. Maximum 12 children.

**Boarding is Available - \$700 per month**

- 2 fenced outdoor arenas with all-weather footing and lights and 1 indoor arena
- 2 outdoor 60' grass round pens and 1 all-weather 60' outdoor round pen
- Access to the Cleveland Metroparks Bridle Trail
- 2 wash racks – 1 indoor with hot and cold water and 1 outdoor
- Aisle ceiling fans
- Horses are fed hay + grain 3x a day and watered 3-4x a day depending on the weather
- Stalls (10x11) are cleaned Monday-Saturday by Valley Riding Employees and can be cleaned on Sunday for \$10.00
- Limited turnout available for \$3.00 a day
